My Name is Sanjana Kaur. I am 15 years old and I study in class IX in VGS. I joined Vimukti in class K.G in the year 2007. My father is a welder and my mother is a housewife. I have two elder brothers and our family income is around Rs 5000 per month. I used to go to another school but that was very costly and my parents were not able to pay my fees. One day my mother came to know about Vimukti from my neighbor whose daughters were studying here free of cost. So my parents admitted me in VGS. I love to have milk and banana provided here. I always participate in Annual Functions and Sports Day. Last year I got second prize in 200 Meter Race.

I wish that my school be extended upto class XII soon as I don't want to go to any other school for further studies. I want to get into teaching when I grow up so that I can teach poor people who find it difficult to study in good schools due to their financial conditions.
