## Story of Hope

*"I will not stop going to school, come what may"*



I am Suman Dhanka, 16 years old and in class VIII at Vimukti Girls School. After my father's death, bad family circumstances led me to live with my aunt in a slum of Jaipur. As she could not afford school fee and other expenses, she brought me to Vimukti which not only gives free education but also provides free books, uniforms, transportation and a daily glass of milk.

In the year 2013, when I was in class VI, my aunt wanted me to stop attending school as she needed me to help the family earn some money. I fought hard and faced lot of problems but finally convinced her. I was allowed to study, but I now have to work as a maid as well. I work from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm, and then go to school at 1:30 pm by the School Bus. Because Vimukti runs all through most of the year and takes only 4 hours of my daily time, I can both learn and earn a little to help the family.

Vimukti has helped me build my confidence and made me believe that despite being poor, I can complete my schooling and even go for higher studies. I want to become self dependent and help my own self, my family and the society.
